The **Northwestern Pritzker School of Law Mentorship Program** welcomes incoming JD and JD-MBA students to the law school and connects them with alumni mentors. These mentors help the students to navigate their experience at Northwestern Law, from the start of 1L year through the first year post-graduation. Priority is given to first-generation students and those without access to similar support in their personal networks. The program is designed to be flexible for mentors and mentees and pairs are encouraged to meet – remotely or in-person – on a monthly basis. Pairs are invited to orientations, socials and panel discussions.

The **Kellogg Alumni Mentorship Program** welcomes all Full Time, Evening and Weekend and JD-MBA students and connects them to a network of Kellogg alumni mentors. These mentors help students to help students better understand specific industries and functions, as well as to facilitate professional connections. The program is flexible, and pairs decide how often they want to meet at the onset. Mentors and mentees are prompted to work through the program's milestones together.
